





The running joke in Las Vegas and Los Angeles, is that the cities are practically neighbors; a "hop, skip and jump" away. That joke is rooted in fact though. According to the Las Vegas Review Journal and the U.S. Census Bureau, more than 50,000 Californians moved to Nevada from July 2017 to July 2018. With them, they bring their fanhood of their favorite California sports teams and the Los Angeles Lakers are no different.

While Vegas is a sports city on the rise, we have not arrived just yet with an NBA (National Basketball Association) team. So, if you are a California transplant and a Lakers fan, where do you go out here to be amongst your own? Insert the Vegas Lakers Fans club. It is a fan-made club that gathers to watch Lakers games at Eclipse Theatres.

Formed in 2010 by a group of friends (Ray Villalobos, Tony Torres, William

Hall, Jamal Anthony and Garald Hill), the need to form this group came from a simple concept: Lakers fans wanting to watch games amongst their own.

The original location that the club got together to watch games was at Straight Up Bar and Lounge (currently closed down) off of Tropicana and Fort Apache.

"Well, basically it was Ray's idea," said Hall. "He reached out to me and wanted to have a meeting with him and several others on an idea that he had regarding the Lakers fans in the area."

"We chose that place because aside from the bar, there was a dining/lounge area," said Villalobos, the founder of the club. "And they had a projector with a screen so, it was pretty cool."

To spread the word in a pre-social media world, they had to create flyers and pass them out or put them on people's windshields, whatever they could do to let everyone know about this newly formed club.

Unfortunately, life got in the way and forced the guys to take a long sabbatical from running the group and promoting it to a bigger audience.

"It was tough because he (Ray) moved out of Vegas for a while, Will was getting his career started, I settled down; so, a break was needed," said Torres.

In 2018, the idea was brought back up and Eclipse Theatres was mentioned as the potential location to have it. Watching Lakers games on the big screen in a luxury movie theater in downtown Las Vegas; it seemed perfect.

"When LeBron decided to join the Lakers, we just knew that we had to get up and running again," said Hall. "That's when Ray's friend told him about Eclipse and the rest is history."

"I truly believe that Las Vegas is a basketball town," said Villalobos. "The way the city embraced UNLV during their championship runs, the reception toward (NBA) All-Star Weekend (in 2007), Summer League, when Team USA practices here; Vegas loves basketball and wants a team here."

Of course, along with creating something comes great memories attached to them.

"The best memory for me is the opening night at Straight Up," remembered Torres. « "To have 50 people there the first time we put this together was pretty special."

"Opening night of this season when there were 85 people in the theater and we had to use folding chairs to accommodate everyone," remembered Villalobos. "To see how it had

grown from even a year ago when the team was not good to that night was amazing."

As far as what they would love to see with the club in the future, "Kobe visiting and watching with us would be surreal", "...

Later that week on January 31st, before the showing of the Lakers first basketball game since the tragic event, Vegas Lakers Fans had set up a beautiful memorial honoring Kobe and Gianna. Three theatres were blocked off for the group to accommodate everyone wanting to come and pay their respects. It was estimated about 150 people might show up. In reality about 350-400 people showed up. There was media coverage from FOX5 Vegas and 8 News Now as well. Amidst all the chaos, the leaders of Vegas Lakers Fans stayed calm and welcoming to all that came while fulfilling media obligations as well.

So, if you are a Lakers fan or just a basketball fan in general and are looking for a unique experience to watch a Lakers game, come on through and enjoy. Unless you are a Celtics fan. Then stay home. Seriously.



LAS VEGAS AVIATORS BASEBALL

Dig League Weekend! March Madness! The DGolden Knights and Playoffs! The NFL Draft! At no time in the history of Las Vegas has so many sporting events come together and in return the local community will reap millions of dollars in revenue. "There has never been seen anything like this," said Don Logan President and COO of the Las Vegas Aviators Baseball Team, "And we are so Proud that we are leading the way to this historic sports time with Big League Weekend!"

In 2020, there will be four games over two weekends for Big League Weekend including games between the A's (Athletics) and the Indians and then the following weekend the Cubs take on the Reds and the games sold out fast.

Coming fresh off a massively successful inaugural year at a brand-new baseball stadium, the Las Vegas Ballpark, The Aviators hit record numbers of fans and in some cases even drew more fans to games than a Major League Baseball club.

Logan attributes a lot of that to do with the new amazing ballpark but moving the stadium to Summerlin had an equally positive impact.

"We went fishing where the fish are!" said Logan, "We took what Minor League baseball is, which is the highest level of professional baseball below the Major Leagues, and made it about fun, family-oriented entertainment and the community responded."

Logan agrees what the Aviators have done is create a unique sports experience for residents of the community, from special nights and events to even the unique food that is offered which in many cases is far from the usual baseball food found at other parks. Logan also admits they stole some ideas from other ballparks to make the Las Vegas stadium what it became.

Admittedly a lot of the success for the Aviators has been its growing partnerships

over the years. Of late it has been the Howard Hughes Corporation which now owns the Aviators and continues to want to make it better. At the same time there has been the teams' baseball partnerships. First as a farm club of the San Diego Padres, then the Dodgers, followed by the Mets and the Blue Jays and now they are the primary farm club of the Oakland A's.

Logan believes the A's partnership was critical to the success in 2019 and were committed to player development thus dedicated to what takes place at the Las Vegas Aviators. What most people don't realize is how critical that partnership and dedication becomes. Logan says it best, "We have even those new to our 140 games in 152 days, 70 of which are home games, and having partnerships like Howard Hughes and the A's helps make success even more attainable."

As to the future of sports, Logan be-

lieves that the next to come to Vegas will be a Major League Baseball team followed then by the NBA. Logan is not afraid to share his feelings by saying, "For those of us who have lived here for many years, and community, Las Vegas continues to put its best foot forward and the growth of Southern Nevada is limited only by its own dreams and wishes and sports has become a critical part of what is helping to drive that growth forward!"







Once thought to diminish or degrade those sacred vows, eloping to Fabulous Las Vegas has become a much more romantic and picturesque proposition, thanks to Las Vegas Destination Wedding and Elopement Expert, McKenzi Taylor. McKenzi's company, Cactus Collective Weddings, helps couples plan intimate destination weddings, and yes, elopements, in Las Vegas in a new and inspiring way.

"People come to us looking for that intoxicating combination of glamour, excitement and turn-key ease. We handle location permits, the ceremony, a champagne and cake reception, extra added touches to personalize vows, and of course, stunning photography," says McKenzi. A Las Vegas local since 2013, she anticipates coordinating 400+ of these weddings in 2020.

"We're creating experiences for couples to get married surrounded by million-dollar views, for just a few thousand dollars," she adds. Though many of her clients choose to elope privately, some couples bring up to twenty, or even up to fifty guests with them. McKenzi does work with local couples, but most of her clients leave the details to her and fly in just before their big day.

"People now realize that eloping to Las Vegas doesn't have a be so cookie cutter. Couples can make this an elegant destination experience."

It's Cool to be Kind to the Environment

Beyond giving each bride and groom romantic memories and stunning photos, she provides couples with weddings that are kind to the environment, something she says is not common enough in the events industry, but it should be. "Our industry is the second largest producer of environmental waste, second only to the construction industry. Being that my clients get married in natural outdoor settings, I feel a responsi-

bility to leave as light a footprint as possible," states McKenzi.

Holding these wedding ceremonies and receptions in outdoor locations greatly cuts down on energy use. From lighting to air conditioning, the energy waste is reduced to almost nothing. Another huge benefit to these natural desert settings is couples completely forego the renting or purchasing of a lot of décor, since nature has that covered.

Taking Sustainable Weddings to Another Level

In addition to marrying couples in Las Vegas' most noteworthy natural wonders, McKenzi Taylor is a stickler for working with eco-friendly, sustainable vendors who also pri-

Before last decade which saw the debut of the Golden Knights, the agreement to move the Raiders to Las Vegas and the arrival of the Lights, Aviators and Aces, sports in Las Vegas was sparse at best. There had been teams in other small, proam leagues but they came and went without establishing an identity.

Then in 1973, the UNLV basketball program hired Jerry Tarkanian as their head basketball coach. Wildly successful at his last stop (Long Beach State) but still an unknown commodity, nationally. UNLV had Final Four teams in 1977 and 1987 but just could not get over the hump.

The 1989-1990 team would change all of that in a major way. Following the transfer of NJCAA (National Junior College Athletic Association) Player of the Year, Larry Johnson and returning nine rotation players, the Runnin' Rebels went 35-5 and won the National Championship in dominant fashion; to this day still holds the record for margin of victory in the NCAA men's basketball national title game.

Scurry: That'll forever have a place in my heart, man. I get asked that often around the city and somehow, I still haven't absorbed it. The feeling doesn't truly hit until I hear about that moment from others and I don't know why.

Brown: Do you think your '90 title team sparked a love for sports in this city that materialized in the growth that we're now seeing?

Scurry: I think we had a major part of that. You look at the run the Golden Knights had and if they had won it all, our team might have been brought back up with them as the only championship winners here. The campus grew due to the success of the basketball team over the years so I feel we had a huge impact.

Gray: Well when we were in school, we were the only show in town. And now, times have changed. I think we'd still be the toast of the town if we were playing in today's times but with all the sports coming, change was inevitable.







Natural fabrics and natural dyes help inspire to create designs that have a sustainable edge that you can wash and go. Every fabric must be organic no matter what color and vibrant naturally and beautiful. Just like you, no two pieces are quite the same, but all are made with the same level of passion and care. You can love a piece that you know was created with conscious transparency and chic care.

SIMONE: How did you start your fashion business?

I started in high school in L.A. where unique and different was the trend I created looks but never told anyone I made them. Then at school at AI Las Vegas I saw "True Cost" the movie about the fashion industry exploitation of people and I decided to start my business with natural locally dyed natural textiles to support the Sustainable edgy part of fashion. Ecofriendly is about knowing about your clothing and begin transparent with the creation of style so that those that wear them look great and know that they were not created by people who are oppressed by the clothing industry. Style should be about conscious fashion and fun which is at the heart of my ecofriendly fashion journey.

SIMONE: Describe your brand.

RESIDENCIES IN LAS VEGAS HAVE DIFFERENT MEANINGS

It's a common nomenclature now in Las Vegas to say a headlining star has a residency. You'll hear superstars like Jennifer Lopez, Gwen Stefani, Shania Twain, Pitbull, Lionel Richie etc. on talks shows saying they have a residency in Las Vegas, which may lead one to believe they appear in town constantly. In truth, they usually have scattered dates throughout the year where they return to the city.

Then you may hear them say they're beginning or ending a residency, only to pop up again a year later starting another one. It's interesting how loosely the term "residency" is used. The word seems to have replaced more common verbiage used in the past like engagement and gig.

The proliferation of the expression began when Celine Dion made the bold move in 2003 to open a true "residency" at The Colosseum at Caesars Palace, which was built for her featuring more than 4,000 seats and with the last remodel some standing room in the pit area. Resort management held their breath wondering if one person could fill such a huge room on a near nightly basis. It turned out there are superstars who followed Dion and could accomplish the task as well such as Elton John, Rod Stewart, Bette Midler, Cher, Shania Twain and Mariah Carey.

Dion still holds the record at The Colosseum with lengthy residencies there from 2003-2007 and again 2011-2019. One reason a superstar might take on the enduring task is they enjoy staying in one place and not having to tour all the time. Dion made a strong commitment and became a resident owning a home at Lake Las Vegas and could be home with her growing family.

Since the early 2000s, more super-size showrooms have been added to Las Vegas' entertainment inventory...T-Mobile Arena, Park MGM, and Zappos Theater at Planet Hollywood with more to come.

There was a time in the middle of the last century when there was a stigma and some stars didn't want to perform in Las Vegas, much like movie stars didn't want to have shows on television. For both genres, times have changed and it's hard to go a day without hearing something about Las Vegas. What is missing though is a resident TV show. With Jimmy Kimmel having been raised in Las Vegas, it would be a match if he did his late-night talk show from his hometown. No longer can anyone say they'd have trouble getting guests or attracting an audience.

While the superstars are noted for having short, limited, or whatever determined residencies, which are hit or miss for folks planning a trip to Las Vegas, the resident show deserves a shout out. Those shows you can count on being in town when you visit are the true meaning of residency. However, you may have to look up where the show is



appearing because they are shuffled around like a deck of cards.

Today's longest running resident production show is "Legends in Concert," which opened at the former Imperial Palace 36 years ago and now calls the Tropicana home. This show stays fresh changing the tribute artists on a regular basis as well as the costumes and choreography.

Probably the credit for the longest afternoon resident show goes to comedy magician Mac King who has been at Harrah's for 20-plus years. You can find him performing his famous live goldfish trick, visual gags, sleight of hand combined with his quirky humor two shows a day, five days a week.

"America's Got Talent" deserves credit for providing visibility and resident opportunities for Terry Fator at The Mirage for 10plus years and more recently Mat Franco at the LINQ, both in main showrooms, and in smaller cabaret-like spaces Piff the Magic Dragon at the Flamingo and Tape Face at Harrah's.

Other constant production shows which have made their indelible mark include "Blue Man Group" now at the Luxor after Criss Angel moved his "Mindfreak" show from there to Planet Hollywood. Legendary magician David Copperfield has made a cozy place for himself at the MGM Grand.

More than 10 years ago we watched a foursome from Australia where they were famous migrate to the showroom at Imperial Palace calling themselves Human Nature. Their residency is now at the Sands Showroom in The Venetian.

Trying to emulate their success and succeeding is Bronx Wanderers. For some time, the father-sons act tried to make it in Las Vegas and finally landed a perma-

> nent gig aka residency at the LINQ and recently moved next door to the Harrah's showroom.

> With Donny and Marie Osmond departing the Flamingo showroom after 11 years, the world premiere of "RuPaul's Drag Race Live!" is making the attempt to secure the residency there for years to come. The revue highlights over-the-top extravagant costumes, stunning sets and eye appealing drag performances. Each show features six queens from a rotating cast.

Las Vegas is also home to many magnificent big Cirque du Soleil spectaculars created for big showrooms such as Beatles-themed "Love" at The Mirage, "KÅ" at the MGM Grand, "Michael Jackson One" at Mandalay Bay, and "Mystère" at Treasure Island.

Over the past half century, it's interesting to see how entertainment has blossomed and bloomed rightfully earning Las Vegas the title of "Entertainment Capital." Times have changed, the stigma is removed, and nearly everyone wants to perform in the city and make their mark.

Monopoly continues to be a popular game about buying-selling hotels. Maybe it's time for someone to invent a game about resident headliners in Las Vegas coming and going and resident shows playing musical chairs.
